**F. CULTURAL DIVERSITY:** In addition to fulfilling the Cultural Diversity requirement, these courses may also be used to fulfill some of the above G.E. requirements, essentially using 1 course to complete 2 requirements. This double counting of a class may only be done with the Cultural Diversity requirement.
