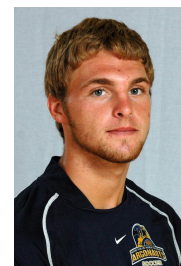

### ARGO OF THE WEEK

#### **SHELDON STEENHUIS, FR., MORGAN HILL, CA MEN'S SOCCER**

Steenhuis helped lead the NDNU men's soccer team to a 1-1 record last week in the Lumberjack Classic held at Humboldt State. Steenhuis allowed one goal in 135:00 minutes of action, including a shutout of Humboldt in his first career start. He made total saves in the tournament and currently has a 0.67 goals against average. In addition, Steenhuis was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Goalie and was named to the All-Tournament Team.

#### **Men's Soccer (2-3)**

##### *Last Week's Results:*

#### **Lumberjack Classic: lost to St. Martin's, 0-1 (9/1) and def. Humboldt State, 1-0 (9/3)**

The Notre Dame de Namur men's soccer team split a pair of games over the Labor Day weekend at the Humboldt State Lumberjack Classic. The Argos dropped the first game against Saint Martin's 1-0 on Saturday before downing the host school 1-0 on Monday.

In the first game, the Argos could not get anything going on offense against Saint Martin's. NDNU was only out shot by one for the game, but managed just one shot on goal. Saint Martin's broke a scoreless tie in the 86th minute when Daniel Palmero scored on a rebound off a save by goalie Sheldon Steenhuis.

On Monday, the Argos responded by beating Humboldt State 1-0. Andres Caballero's goal in the 18th minute was the difference as NDNU moved their record to 2-3 on the season. Caballero scored off a Carlos Lopez assist after a Lumberjack turnover. Sheldon Steenhuis, making his first start in goal, recorded a shutout by making six saves.

Steenhuis was named Most Outstanding Goalkeeper for the tournament and was named to the 2007 Quiznos Soccer Classic Men's All-Tournament Team. Joining Steenhuis on the All-Tournament Team were Andres Caballero, Nick Casagrande and Carlos Lopez.

**lost to CSU San Bernardino, 0-1 (8/29):** The Notre Dame de Namur men's soccer team dropped a tough game to CSU San Bernardino 1-0 despite out shooting the Coyotes 18-8. The Argos had several chances to get on the board throughout the game, but could not put the ball past goalkeeper Lucas Pepi. The game moved into halftime scoreless with the Argos recording six shots on goal compared to zero from the Coyotes. Robert Morini hit the post on a penalty kick late in the half to keep the game tied at 0-0. In the second, San Bernardino got on the board in the 53rd minute when Lorenzo Loson took a pass from Daniel Rodriguez and drilled it into the back of the net. The Argos appeared to tie the game late in the second half on a header by Morini, but the corner kick went out of bounds thus disallowing the goal.

## **Women's Soccer (0-3-1)**

### **Lumberjack Classic: lost to St. Martin's, 1-2 (9/1) and t Humboldt State, 1-0 (9/3)**

The Notre Dame de Namur women's soccer team battled to a loss and a tie at the Lumberjack Classic in Arcata. The Argos dropped a tough one to Saint Martin's on a last minute goal before battling Humboldt State to a 1-1 tie on Monday.

On Saturday, the Argos found themselves down early to Saint Martin's after Ashley Biral scored in the 30th minute. However, NDNU even the score less than four minutes later on a goal by Lesley Welch. With the game tied at one in the final minute, Trisha Halvorson scored off a corner from Jessica Wilson to put the Saints up for good.

In the second game, the Argos and Lumberjacks battled to a 1-1 tie after regulation and two overtimes. NDNU scored first, taking advantage of a breakaway opportunity following a Lumberjack corner kick late in the first half. Stacie Nowak carried the ball down the length of the field, one-on-one against a Humboldt defender. With the rest of the Lumberjacks defense trailing the play, Nowak laid the ball back to Kristin Mills who sent a long lofting shot over keeper Chandra Gaskalla for the score. In the final minutes of regulation, Humboldt tied the score when Meghan Connolly tipped in a long ball sent into the box by Sarah Ingram in the 88th minute. The Argos were out shot 11-9 for the game but were kept in by Allie Horwath who turned away five shots, including two in overtime.

Stacie Nowak, Erin Morrison, Kristin Mills and Lesley Welch were all selected to the 2007 Quiznos Soccer Classic Women's All-Tournament Team for their efforts over the weekend. The Argos are off to Washington this weekend to face Central Washington and Seattle Pacific in a pair of non-conference games.

### **Otter Invitational (8/30-9/1):**

The Notre Dame de Namur volleyball team fought to a 1-3 record at the CSU Monterey Bay Otter Invitational over the weekend. The Argos battled all weekend and faced two ranked teams, including #2 University of Tampa.

**def. CSU Monterey Bay, 3-1 (8/30):** In the opening match of the tourney, the Argos downed the host CSU Monterey Bay 3-1. The Otter's took the first game 30-26 before NDNU stormed back to win the final three games 30-27, 30-27 and 30-28.

**lost to #2 Tampa, 1-3 (9/1):** The second match on Friday pitted the Argos against #2 ranked University of Tampa. Tampa went ahead early winning the first game 30-23 before the Argos evened it up with a 30-25 win in game two. However, Tampa responded

by taking the final two game 30-17 and 30-17. Marissa Miller led the Argos with 14 kills while Lauren Quach added 19 digs. Alisha Green led four Tampa players in double figures with 21 kills and Gabriela Saade finished with 63 assists.

**lost to Saginaw Valley State, 1-3 (9/1):** On Saturday, the Argos fell to Saginaw Valley State in four games despite an early lead. NDNU jumped out to a 1-0 lead before SVS took the final three games to earn the victory. Emily Evans finished with 11 kills while Marissa Miller added 10 to lead the Argos. Saginaw had four players reach double figures in kills with Allison Schlinkert leading the way with 17.

**lost to #20 Seattle Pacific, 2-3 (9/1):** In the final match of the tournament the Argos dropped tough one to #20 Seattle Pacific in five games. NDNU took the opening game 30-28 before SPU won the next two 30-24 and 30-19. The Argos pulled out a 30-28 win in a must win fourth game, but dropped the deciding fifth game 15-9. Emily Evans and Marris Miller once again led the Argos with 13 and 10 kills respectively. Seattle Pacific finished the match with a 74-45 kill advantage, and had two players with over 20 kills.
