MEN'S GOLF

Dean set a school record at the Western Washington Invitational by shooting a five-under-par, 211. Henry finished tied for fourth individually and helped lead the men to a fourth place team finish.

TEAMS

VOLLEYBALL (7-14, 0-6)

Last Week's Results:

lost to Dixie State 3-0 (9/29): The Notre Dame de Argonauts could not hold off the Dixie State volleyball team, falling in three games (24-30, 25-30, 34-36). The Argos could not get the lead on the Rebels in the first two games, but fought hard in the final game. NDNU trailed 29-23 in the third game, before a furious rally sent the game into extra points. Dixie State eventually took the match by winning the game 36-34.

lost to Dixie State 3-1 (9/30): The Argos dropped their second straight match to Dixie State College, falling to 7-14 on the season. The Rebels took the match in four games (28-30, 30-24, 25-30, 22-30), out hitting the Argos 66-45 in the kills department. After losing the first game, NDNU won the second to even the match at one game a piece. Dixie State responded by taking the final two games to end the match.

MEN'S SOCCER (5-4-2)

Last Week's Results:

lost to Seattle Pacific 2-1 (2OT) (9/25): The NDNU men's soccer team dropped a 2-1 heartbreaker to Seattle Pacific on a game winning penalty shot in double overtime. The two teams battled to a 1-1 tie through regulation and the first overtime before Michael Morris hammered home the winning goal in the 102nd minute.

def. Grand Canyon 1-0 (9/29): The NDNU men used an Eric Michon goal with just 12 seconds left in the first half to win their Pac West opener over Grand Canyon. The Argos and Lopes battled throughout the first half with each team recording several shots on goal. However, in the 44th minute Michon took a long pass from Anthony Putrus and snuck it by Franco Carotenuto for the only goal of the game.

lost to Grand Canyon 1-0 (10/1): The Argos could not hold off the Grand Canyon Antelopes in a 2-1 double overtime loss. The 'Lopes scored both goals on free kicks from just beyond the box to erase an early one goal deficit. NDNU had 19 shots to only seven from the 'Lopes, and just missed putting the game away several times.

WOMEN'S SOCCER (4-6-1)

Last Week's Results:

def. Grand Canyon 2-0 (9/29): The NDNU women's soccer team started off Pac West play by shutting out Grand Canyon University 2-0. Amy Armijo scored both goals for the Argos who were on the attack all night long. Armijo's first goal, on assists from Ashlee Hinojosa and Hope Siffert gave NDNU a 1-0 lead in the 33rd minute. She would score again on an assist from Hinojosa with just 17 seconds left to seal the game.

tied Grand Canyon 1-1 (2OT) (10/1): The NDNU women's soccer team battled the Grand Canyon Antelopes to a 1-1 tie at De Anza College. The Argos fell behind in the first half when Stephanie Borrow beat Candice Schrodetzki in the 32nd minute to give the 'Lopes a 1-0 lead. NDNU evened the score ten minutes later when a handball led to an Ashlee Hinojosa penalty kick. Hinojosa went to the lower right corner, getting the shot past Jun Munger and tying the game at 1-1. The scoring would end there as both goalies would not let anything get past them.

Concordia University (Irvine) took home the men's and women's team titles. The NDNU men finished in 24th place, while the women placed 31st.

Men (4th place) in Western Washington Invitational (9/25-9/26): The NDNU men's golf team used a pair of top ten individual performances to take fourth place in the WWU Invitational. The Argos finished just 14 shots behind Western Washington who took home the title in the 14 team, 54-hole tournament.

Women (6th place) in Grand Canyon Fall Invitational (9/25-9/26): The Notre Dame de Namur women's golf team got their season started with a sixth place finish at the Grand Canyon Women's Fall Invitational. The Argos finished 29 strokes behind tournament winner CSU San Marcos in the 12-team field.
