ERIC MICHON, SR., SAN CARLOS, CA MEN'S SOCCER

Michon helped lead the NDNU men's soccer team to its fifth straight win, with a 3-2 victory over 15th ranked Seattle University. Michon scored two goals in the contest, upping his team leading total to 11 goals on the season. His first goal came in the 41st minute on a crossing pass from Nick Hooper to tie the game at 1-1. Michon later added a very important insurance goal, giving the Argos a 3-1 lead in the 83rd minute. He worked a give-and-go with Anton Del Rosario that resulted in a breakaway for Michon.

Volleyball (10-21, 0-12)

Last Week's Results:

lost to Chaminade 3-0 (10/20): The Notre Dame de Namur Argonauts could not hold off the Chaminade Silverswords, falling in three games (22-30, 16-30, 21-30). Chaminade used big leads in all three games to get ahead of the Argos and never look back. The Silverswords hit .378 for the match, including .500 in the first game of the night. Overall, they out killed the Argos 51 to 30 and added 10 aces. Val Adams led NDNU with eight kills on the night, while Marissa Miller and Emily Evans added six apiece Jennifer McMurtry and Shasta Millhollin combined for 26 kills with Shauna Folan picking up 11 digs.

lost to Chaminade 3-0 (10/21): The NDNU volleyball team dropped its second straight match to the Chaminade Silverswords in a three game sweep (26-30, 23-30, 22-30). The Argos battled tough all night, taking leads in the first two games, but could not hold off the Swords attack. Chaminade racked up 52 kills to 38 from NDNU and hit .296 for the match. The Argos played their best in the first game, connecting on 15 kills and committing only two errors. Marissa Miller paced the Argos attack, tallying 14 kills and a game high 15 digs. Emily Evans added 10 kills while Jennifer McMurtry picked up 30 assists.

def. #15 Seattle University 3-2 (10/19): The NDNU men's soccer team continued its hot streak, winning their fifth consecutive game with a 3-2 victory over Seattle University. Erik Michon had his second straight two goal game and Anthony Putrus added another to round out the NDNU scoring. The Argos found themselves down early when Pat Thomas netted a penalty kick in the 23rd minute. Michon would tie the game in the 41st minute when he took a crossing pass from Nick Hooper and knocked it off the crossbar and into the net. The Argos put another goal on the board just four minutes into the second half to go up 2-1. Dorian Virrueta played a ball over the defense that Putrus ran down and put past goalie Jordan Jennings. Both teams remained on the attack but could not score until Michon's second goal in the 83rd minute. Michon and Anton Del Rosario worked a give-and-go to put the Argos up 3-1.

The race, which took place in Hilo, Hawaii featured all six schools in the conference. The men and women each finished fourth in their respective races.

Women (7th place) in Golf Mart/Lady Otter Invitational (10/16-10/18): The Notre Dame de Namur women's golf team used a top 10 finish from Brittany Carrera to place sixth in The Golf Mart/Lady Otter Invitational. CSU Chico took home first place in the 54 hole, 16 team tournament. The Argos shot a combine 1037, finishing 51 strokes behind the tournament winner. NDNU's 333 in the third round was the second best score of the day. Carrera finished with a 249 on the tournament, good enough for ninth place. Kelly Owen placed 25th for the Argos, followed by a 31st place finish for Angie Manzitto.
