### ARGO OF THE WEEK

#### **ANTHONY PUTRUS, SR., SPRING VALLEY, CA MEN'S SOCCER**

Putrus helped lead the NDNU men's soccer team to a 2-0 week with wins over Hawaii-Pacific and BYU Hawaii. He scored three goals and recorded two assists in the two wins. In a 5-1 victory over Hawaii-Pacific on Thursday, Putrus scored a pair of goals and assisted on another. His second goal came on a shot from midfield that he chipped over the goalie head and into the net. On Saturday, Putrus assisted on the first goal of the game and later scored the final goal in a 3-0 win over BYU Hawaii. For the season, he leads the team with eight goals, six assists and 22 points.



### Teams

#### Volleyball (7-16, 0-8)

##### *Last Week's Results:*

**lost to #8 BYU Hawaii 3-0 (10/3):** The NDNU women's volleyball team could not hold off the BYU Hawaii attack, losing in three games to the #8 ranked team. The Seaside swept the Argos (22-30,12-30,20-30) for the second time this season and dropped NDNU's record to 7-15. The Argos kept it close in the first game before an eight point spurt by BYU put the game out of reach. In the final two games, the Seaside proved to be too much, combining for 32 kills and only eight errors.

**lost to #8 BYU Hawaii 3-1 (10/4):** The Notre Dame de Namur Argonauts could not hold off the BYU Hawaii attack for the second straight night, losing in four games (32-30,14-30,24-30,20-30). The Seasiders completed the season sweep of the NDNU and dropped the Argos to 7-16 on the season. NDNU came out strong, mounting a furious comeback and taking the first game 32-30. However, BYU rebounded in the final three games to take the match. NDNU committed just one error in the first game, and 19 in the match compared to 29 from BYU. The Seasiders did out kill the Argos 74-42 and notched 12 aces.

## **Men's Soccer (7-4-2, 3-1)**

*Last Week's Results:*

**def. Hawaii Pacific 5-1 (10/5):** The Notre Dame de Namur Argonauts used four second half goals to defeat Hawaii Pacific 5-1 and improve to 6-4-2 on the season. Anthony Putrus scored a pair of goals and added an assist to lead the NDNU attack which recorded a season high 28 shots.

**def. BYU Hawaii 3-0 (10/7):** The NDNU Argonauts improved to 7-4-2 on the season and upped their conference record to 3-1 with a shutout of BYU Hawaii. The Argos took an early lead and never looked backed, out shooting the Seasiders 20-5. Nick Hooper put NDNU up in the 13th minute when he took a touch pass from Anthony Putrus and put it in the back of the net. The Argos tacked on two more goals early in the second half, with the first coming from Rigo Pinal just three minutes into the half.

## **Women's Soccer (6-6-1, 3-0-1)**

*Last Week's Results:*

**def. Hawaii Pacific 2-0 (10/5):** The NDNU women's soccer team improved to 5-6-1 on the season with a 2-0 victory over Hawaii Pacific. The Argos were on the attack all game, racking up a season high 32 shots including 22 shots on goal. The game stayed scoreless late into the second half before Morghan King took a crossing pass from Kaia Wakamiya in the 83rd minute and put it in the net. Wakamiya would add an insurance goal in the 88th minute to give the Argos a 2-0 win.

**def. BYU Hawaii 1-0 (10/7):** The Notre de Namur Argonauts remained undefeated in Pac West play with a 1-0 victory over BYU Hawaii. NDNU improved to 6-6-1 overall and are 3-0-1 in conference games. The Argos were on the attack from the start, tallying 13 shots to just seven from the Seasiders. NDNU went up in the 48th minute when Yang Zhou corner kick was headed into the net by Shana Chibidakis. The goal was the first allowed by BYU in its last seven games and would prove to be all the Argos would need.
