Converting Quarter Credits to NDNU's Semester Credits

Some institutions operate on a Quarter System, and the credits from those institutions must be converted to NDNU's Semester System before they can appear on NDNU transcripts. A course taken at an institution using the Quarter System will always show a greater number of credits than can be conferred by an institution on the Semester System. An institution on the Semester System, like NDNU, transfers in <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/journal.

EXAMPLE:

Jason the Argonaut attended a local college on the QUARTER SYSTEM and earned 5 CREDITS.

[QUARTER CREDITS * 2] / 3 = SEMESTER CREDITS

5 CREDITS multiplied by 2 = 10 CREDITS 10 CREDITS divided by 3 = 3.33 CREDITS

Jason the Argonaut will receive 3.33 CREDITS at NDNU.

Here are the most common credit conversions:

| QUARTER CREDITS | SEMESTER CREDITS (at NDNU) |
|-----------------|----------------------------|
| 0.5 | 0.33 |
| 1.0 | 0.67 |
| 1.5 | 1.00 |
| 2.0 | 1.33 |
| 3.0 | 2.00 |
| 4.0 | 2.67 |
| 4.5 | 3.00 |
| 5.0 | 3.33 |
| 6.0 | 4.00 |
