Academic Progress at Notre Dame de Namur University

To be eligible for graduation with a bachelor's degree from Notre Dame de Namur University, a student must meet the following:

- Major Requirements
- Institutional Requirements
- General Education Requirements

A total of 124 semester units are required for the bachelor's degree. These must include a minimum of 46 units in upper-division courses. To be eligible for academic honors, students must satisfy a minimum of 46 letter graded upper-division units at NDNU.


Important tips before registering for classes:

Course History – An easy-to-read chart of all your courses, grades and units at NDNU. You can see courses that transferred in and which requirements they met.


