Grant applications should include the following, attached to this form.

- 1. Title and summary of faculty development project being proposed.
- 2. Activities and methodology.
- 3. Purpose and value for you and for NDNU.
- 4. Estimated timetable for conducting and completing activities.
- 5. Audience for whom your results might be published or presented.
- 6. Itemized budget, which may include stipends.

Acceptance of research grant funds includes a commitment by the faculty member to present their results at a faculty colloquium the semester following the grant's award.
