## Bachelor of Arts in Psychology

Notre Dame de Namur University (NDNU) has partnered with the San Mateo County Community College District (SMCCCD) to create a seamless pathway to a bachelor's degree for students when they complete their Associate in Arts for Transfer in Psychology. All 60 AA-T Psychology credits transfer to NDNU. NDNU offers the remaining 60 units of upper-division coursework so students can complete their Bachelor of Arts in Psychology (BA Psychology) in 2 years.

### DISTINCTIONS OF THE NDNU BA PSYCHOLOGY

- Classes will conveniently be offered at the Cañada College campus.
- Scholarships and financial aid provide cost comparable to public institutions.
- Designed for working adults
- Attend classes 2 nights per week
- 8-week intensive courses offered in hybrid format

- Earn up to 12 units of graduate course work that can be applied to a Master of Science in Clinical Psychology.
