



General Education Transfer Credit Agreement 2017-2018 Catalog

This transfer agreement describes how courses taken at Lake Tahoe Community College will transfer to meet Notre Dame de Namur University requirements for General Education and lower division major preparation. Please note: you do not need to complete all of these requirements before transferring to NDNU.

Policy for Awarding Transfer Credit. With the exception of remedial or vocational courses, NDNU accepts credit for courses completed with grade "C" (2.0) or higher at any degree-granting regionally-accredited two-year college or four-year college or university. Courses from California Community Colleges are generally accepted according to the published recommendations for transfer of courses to the California State University system.

Conversion of Quarter Units to Semester Units. NDNU is on the semester system. Quarter units are based on 30 hours of instruction; semester units on 40 hours. 3 qtr units = 2 sem units 4 qtr units = 2.67 sem units 4.5 qtr units = 3.0 sem units 5 qtr units = 3.33 sem units 6 qtr units = 4 sem units. *Note: an LTCC course that is 4 quarter units (2.67 semester units) may be used to satisfy the content of a 3 semester unit GE requirement, but only 2.67 semester units will be awarded. The student will need to make up the missing .33 units, if required, to complete 124 semester units for graduation.*



SECTION A: World History (3 sem.)

SECTION B: A second course in World History (above) is required for first-time freshmen, and preferred for transfer students. Transfer students may also satisfy the Section B requirement through one of the following General History courses.

WORLD HISTORY. First-time Freshmen: Students entering with no college credit at the time of matriculation to NDNU may fulfill this requirement by taking and passing HST 1000 and HST 1010. **Transfer Students:** Students entering with college credit at the time of matriculation to NDNU may transfer a World History course to satisfy the Section A or Section B requirement; or may take an approved general history course to satisfy the Section B requirement. At least (3) of the (6) units required must be in World History. A course in Western Civilization may not be applied to the World History general education requirement, but may transfer for general elective credit.

MODERN LANGUAGE/CULTURE AND LANGUAGE. For majors leading to a B.S. degree, Foreign Culture and Language courses may be substituted for Foreign Language.
