Transferring made Simple. The Transfer Pathways program eliminates the obstacles with the transition from the Community College to the Bachelor of Science (BS) programs in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) programs at Notre Dame de Namur University (NDNU).

NDNU accepts transfer students for both spring and fall terms with any number units. Our counselors and advisors will work with you to determine an individualized academic plan to map out and get you into the classes you need to graduate on time. Students seeking a 2 + 2 transfer agreement can use this pathway document as a guide. Please keep in mind that not every course needs to be completed. We will assist you to determine your individual needs.

STEM Articulation Pathway toward a B.S. In Kinesiology

The following classes outline prerequisite courses taken at Cañada, and specific upper division courses that must be taken at NDNU for the Kinesiology major.

General Education Requirements

You should plan to complete at least 28 units from the online Articulation Agreement between Cañada College and NDNU, including both required Core Cultural Diversity courses. The total number of units needed to fulfill all Core Curriculum and institutional requirements will vary depending on how requirements for foreign language and US History are met.
