At least (3) of the (6) units required must be in World History. A course in Western Civilization may not be applied to the World History general education requirement, but may transfer for general elective credit.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT. Additional courses, such as internships, may transfer upon review of the syllabus and other requested documentation. A Community Engagement Course engages faculty, students, and community in mutually beneficial and respectful collaboration, and requires students to complete at least 15 hours of community work. The Community Engagement Requirement may be double counted with courses from the approved list that also satisfy requirements in other areas of the student's program. This double counting of a class may only be done with the Community Engagement or Cultural Diversity requirements.
