Policy for Awarding Transfer Credit. With the exception of remedial or vocational courses, NDNU accepts credit for courses completed with grade "C" (2.0) or higher at any degree-granting regionally-accredited two-year college or four-year college or university. Courses from California Community Colleges are generally accepted according to the published recommendations for transfer of courses to the California State University system.

Such a course engages faculty, students, and community in mutually beneficial and respectful collaboration, and requires students to complete at least 15 hours of community work. These interactions address community-identified needs, deepen students' civic and academic learning, enhance community well-being, and enrich the scholarship of the institution.

CULTURAL DIVERSITY. The Cultural Diversity Requirement generally does not add units to a student's program. Rather, it is intended to be fulfilled by choosing courses from the approved list that also satisfy requirements in other areas of the student's program; the exception is that Cultural Diversity courses may not satisfy Culture and Language Requirements for B.S. students. For example, ICS 7 – Intercultural Communication, can fulfill (3) units of the Behavioral Science requirement and (3) units of the Cultural Diversity requirement. This double counting of a class may only be done with the Cultural Diversity requirement. Courses in Cultural Diversity may be taken at the lower-division or upper-division level.
