E. GLOBAL CITIZENSHIP (Language)

Modern Languages: Those who have completed 3rd year level of 1 foreign language in high school with grades of C or higher are exempt from the foreign language requirement. For majors leading to a B.S., Foreign Culture and Language (usually taken at NDNU) may be substituted for Foreign Language.

F. CULTURAL DIVERSITY: In addition to fulfilling the Cultural Diversity requirement, these courses may also be used to fulfill some of the above G.E. requirements, essentially using 1 course to complete 2 requirements. For example, Anthropology 110 can fulfill part of the Behavioral Science requirement and part of Cultural Diversity. This double counting of a class may only be done with the Cultural Diversity requirement.
