

Course-to-Course Agreement 2010-2011 Catalog

Notre Dame de Namur University agrees to accept the following Mills-Peninsula Health Services School of Diagnostic Imaging courses as upper-division electives toward the Bachelor of Science in Human Services. Notre Dame de Namur University has evaluated the course descriptions and syllabi and determined that the academic rigor is equivalent to NDNU standards. It is expected that 3 semester units of transferable credit equates normally to 45 hours of instruction, with normally no fewer than 30 hours of instructional time. However, if a student has demonstrated competency in a clinical setting that has been approved by a nationally-recognized accreditation board and is certified for having met all student learning outcomes, hours may vary. Mills-Peninsula Hospitals is accredited by the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology. Based on academic content and rigor, demonstrated competency in a clinical setting, and national accreditation, 3 upper-division elective semester units will be awarded for each of the courses listed below.
