Frequently Asked Questions

1) Who can attend the conference?

Community college transfer counselors and other community college counselors.

2) Can students attend the conference?

No, but they can be nominated for the Outstanding Transfer Student Award.

3) How do I nominate a student?

Send your name, college, and the full legal name and email of the student you are nominating to:

lknisely@ndnu.edu

You must be present at the conference for your nomination to go into effect.

4) What type of student can I nominate?

The student must be ready to transfer to a four-year college or university in 2020, in spring or summer or fall.

5) What criteria do I use for choosing a student?

Choose a student you think is an outstanding candidate to attend a four-year university.

6) What does a nominated student receive?

Each student gets a certificate designating her/him as an Outstanding Transfer Student.

The nominating counselor will receive the certificate at the conference. Nominees will receive a scholarship to NDNU.

7) What is social mobility?

Upward social mobility is moving from low-income status to middle- or high-income status.

8) How will I receive my \$35 travel allowance?

The travel allowances will be distributed in cash to registered participants at the conference.
