This month, we welcome **John Veitch** who recently joined NDNU as the new Dean of the School of Business and Management. John has over three decades of experience as a faculty member, department chair and associate dean at the University of San Francisco, as well as Assistant Professor at the University of Southern California. He most recently served as Head of Planning for the Learning Experience, Assessment and Development area within the CFA Institute where, among other accomplishments, he mastered an end-to-end view of how to build a skill- and competency-based curriculum, helped transition CFA to a digital first platform and expanded its product portfolio.

I am a serial academic entrepreneur. I like the challenge of taking institutions to the next level by finding ways to help students be more successful, and the organization more responsive to community needs.
