Our Education Specialist Credential program prepares candidates to work with special education students in K-12 settings and up to age 22, focusing on mild/moderate support needs (MMSN) or extensive support needs (ESN). The program covers diverse settings including resource rooms, special education settings, general education settings, special schools, home/hospital settings, and more! Candidates gain proficiency in critical knowledge, assessment, and specialized instruction. Additionally, they can earn a master's degree in special education by completing the Capstone class and portfolio requirements.

Distinctions of the Program

- Tuition is \$595 per unit for a total program cost of \$26,180
- Students complete the 44-unit credential and add the Master of Arts (MA) in Special Education by taking one 3-unit capstone course
- General education teachers can add the special education credential with a master's degree by taking 30 units
- School of Education faculty bring diverse academic and practical expertise teachers and administrators in public and private schools into their advising and instruction

Admissions Requirements

- 2 Letters of Recommendation
- Letter of Intent (Personal Statement)
- Official Transcripts (Proof of BA)
- Interview with a Program Director
- Program-specific requirements as noted in the Catalog including verification of California subject matter competency prior to beginning student teaching

Program Requirements

- CTC Certificate of Clearance (fingerprint clearance)
- Provide a copy of negative tb test result within last 2 years
- Provide verification of meeting the U.S. Constitution requirement by exam, course work, or CSU degree
- Complete CPR training for infant, child, and adult
- Personal interview with program director
